REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Parents with children who will be attending ANY school in the Sturgeon Bay School District should plan on registering their students on either Thursday, August 10, or Tuesday, August 15, between the hours of Noon and 7:00 p.m. in the high school commons. For the convenience of parents, there will be one registration site for all of the elementary, middle and high school age students in the district. School supply lists will be available on the registration days. Due to the registration schedule, the school offices will be closed on these two dates for all non-registration related business.

LUNCH AND MILK PROGRAM

The school district uses a pre-paid system for recording and handling all lunch program transactions. Money must be pre-deposited in a family account. A family authorization form must be completed prior to any purchases, even if you have had an account previously or are only getting milk. Forms will be available on the registration dates above or from the school offices at any later date.

Milk may be purchased at the elementary schools for K-5 mid-morning break plus the afternoon break for kindergarten class. There will be a \$.35 charge for each milk.

Chocolate or white milk will be served with each school lunch in all schools.

Additional milk will be available at lunch time in all schools for \$.35 per carton.

TRANSPORTATION

Bus registration is required for all students who wish to ride a Kobussen Buses LTD bus to or from school during the 2017-2018 school year. Registration forms, with route information, will be available on the registration dates listed above or from the Kobussen Buses LTD office at any later date.

INSURANCE

The district will make available to interested parents a Student Accident Insurance Policy from a private vendor. No individual student accident insurance coverage is provided by the school district. Coverage can be selected on either a 24-hour a day basis, or on a %school time plan. +A brochure describing the optional policy will be available on the registration days which explains the options and premium rates.
