**FAMILY & CONSUMER EDUCATION:** Sewing kits and fabrics as called for during the semester. Prices may vary. Estimated cost of projects is as follows: 8<sup>th</sup> grade – approximately \$20 to \$30,  
7<sup>th</sup> grade - \$10 to \$20  
6<sup>th</sup> grade - \$6.

**MODERN TECHNOLOGY:** Safety glasses will be provided by the school. Estimated cost of projects is as follows:  
8<sup>th</sup> grade - \$25, 7<sup>th</sup> grade - \$26 and 6<sup>th</sup> grade - \$12.

**ART:** An art kit and materials for projects may be purchased from school. Estimated cost for each grade is as follows:  
8<sup>th</sup> grade - \$10, 7<sup>th</sup> grade - \$7 and 6<sup>th</sup> grade \$5. General needs for all grades include a pencil.
