**STURGEON BAY SCHOOL DISTRICT COMMUNITY SURVEY OPEN**

*Residents Reminded to Provide Feedback by November 1, 2019*

**Sturgeon Bay, Wis.** – The Sturgeon Bay School District is providing all District residents the opportunity to provide feedback on the District’s future facilities planning through a community survey. Every household in the Sturgeon Bay School District should have received a survey in their mailbox in mid-October. Please call the District Office at (920) 746-2807 if you did not receive a survey. The survey is open until November 1, 2019.

The District encourages every household to complete the survey, either online using a unique access code or using the paper copy received in the mail. The survey was developed and results will be analyzed by [School Perceptions LLC](#), an independent Wisconsin-based firm with expertise conducting school district surveys. All survey data is returned to School Perceptions to ensure respondent anonymity.

“The district is committed to a transparent process and moving forward with a solution that is crafted from taxpayer feedback and priorities,” said Superintendent Dan Tjernagel. “These decisions could impact our community for decades, so I encourage all residents to participate.”
